






Mike Chase will be with us in person to launch his new book.

The Workshop includes Karmic Journeying developed by Jostein Saether.

This is a richly imaginative exercise that supports the karmic question of the researcher in finding an answer. Working with the imagination of the spiritual hut, described by Rudolf Steiner in *Knowledge of the Higher worlds*, this process invites one to develop a rich imaginative relationship with one's angel. By asking the Angel for support to find the answer, a journey is undertaken, initially through moral imagination, and then intuitively, across the threshold to the time and place where the answer lies.

In addition, **Karmaloka Drama**, developed by Mike, is an embodied interactive process enabling the karma researcher to process and digest past-life traumas, doubles and personalities. This process using masks and psychodramatic action methods, helps work with unconscious pasts of oneself by exploring what the past is asking one to transform for the future. **Workshop:**




Unbornness
